One of the keys to a successful transition to ICD-10-CM/PCS is a thorough understanding of the ICD-10-CM Official Coding Guidelines, which were posted to the National Center for Health Statistics Web site in January 2009.ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting Note: The ICD-9-CM code set is in partial freeze with the transition to ICD-10-CM. The 2012 Guidelines are current.Just like ICD-9-CM, the ICD-10-CM coding guidelines are a set of rules that accompany the official coding conventions and instructions within ICD-10-CM. The ICD-10-CM coding conventions are instructions for the use of the classification system that must be followed for correct code assignment.
