When is the deadline to request an absentee ballot? The County Board of Elections must receive your application for absentee ballot no later than 5 p.m. on the Tuesday before the election. Absentee and One-stop Voting. Voters do not need to provide a reason in order to vote absentee, whether voting absentee in person via one-stop voting or voting absentee by mail. An absentee ballot is a vote cast by someone who is unable or unwilling to attend the official polling station to which the voter is normally allocated. Numerous methods have been devised to facilitate this. Increasing the ease of access to absentee ballots is seen by many as one way to improve voter turnout, though some countries require that a valid reason, such as infirmity or travel, be ...
