

Download Acog Prenatal Care Schedule

Prenatal care visits should occur with the following frequency:

- o Prior to 20 weeks, ideally every 4 weeks but no less than every 6 weeks for lower-risk women.
- o 20 to 28 weeks, every 4 weeks.
- o 28 to 36 weeks, every 2-3 weeks, 3 weeks for lower-risk women.
- o 36 weeks to delivery, at least every week.

Topic Outline. Women with problems are seen more frequently, depending on the nature of the problems. According to this schedule, a woman with an uncomplicated pregnancy in which the first visit is at six weeks of gestation and the last visit is at 41 weeks will have 16 prenatal visits.
