

# Download Florida Food Service Manual

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) regulates the commercial food supply for compliance with state and federal regulations to minimize the risk of foodborne illness in food products processed, produced, stored, distributed and sold in both retail and wholesale food businesses within the state of Florida. To open a food establishment in Florida, you must obtain a food establishment permit from the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS).
