Most legal systems prescribe specific procedures for dealing with juveniles, such as juvenile detention centers and courts, with it being common that juvenile systems are treated as civil cases instead of ...The screening procedure usually conducted by juvenile probation officer to determine whether to release a juvenile offender to parental custody or recommended ...Granted by the Court and as an alternative to Prison, Formal Probation provides an offender with the benefit of supervision in the community by a Probation Officer.
