Be able to read, speak, write, and understand English (exceptions may be made if the person is unable to meet one of these requirements for a medical reason, such as hearing impairment) Be in a physical and mental condition to safely operate a small UAS.A full instruction on how to obtain a drone license can be found on the FAA website, but the general process is as follows: Prepare to take the airman knowledge test by studying.
