

# Download Hurricane Manuel Mexico

Hurricane Manuel (/ ˈ m æ n (j) u ˈ 1, ˈ m ʔ n -/) was the most destructive eastern Pacific tropical cyclone on record. Manuel brought widespread flooding across much of Mexico in September 2013, along with Hurricane Ingrid , which hit the opposite side of the nation the same day as Manuel, the first such occurrence since 1958. Hurricane Manuel 3 Gulf of California around 1800 UTC 16 September, and convective activity began to increase shortly thereafter. A well-defined surface circulation redeveloped by 1800 UTC 17 September, about 150 n mi east of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico, and Manuel once again became a tropical depression.
