Step 5: After solving the mystery, return to the Ingredients for a Mystery Checklist printable. As a class, go through the checklist, checking off the parts that were in the mystery you read to the class. Definition. The mystery genre is a type of fiction in which a detective, or other professional, solves a crime or series of crimes. It can take the form of a novel or short story. This genre may also be called detective or crime novels. The purpose of a mystery novel is to solve a puzzle and to create a feeling of resolution with the audience.
