A syllable is a unit of organization for a sequence of speech sounds. It is typically made up of a syllable nucleus (most often a vowel) with optional initial and final margins (typically, consonants). Syllables are often considered the phonological "building blocks" of words. They can influence the rhythm of a language, its prosody, its poetic metre and its stress patterns. Spoken syllables are organized around a vowel sound. Each word above has two syllables. The jaw drops open when a vowel in a syllable is spoken. When you hear the long E sound, it can be spelled several ways. The long E sound can be represented in 2 vowel teams ("ea" and "ee"), an irregular vowel team ("ie"), the open syllable rule, e.g., me, and "Y" as a vowel at the end of a word, e.g. bunny. 5 Ways to Spell [...] One Syllable Words : To understand word stress, we have to understand syllables.
